

**TENTATIVE PLANNING**  
**REPEAT NORTHERN IRELAND ASSEMBLY ELECTION**  
**December 2022/January 2023**

NOTE: As we are still in the preliminary planning stages, some of this information is subject to change.

We are seeking applications from both experienced and inexperienced Short Term Observers (any nationality).

The observation mission runs from Dec 12 -18 (if the election is called for December 15), inclusive. Here is the rough tentative schedule:

Mon – Dec 12 – Arrive Belfast  
Tues – Dec 13 - Briefing all day, deploy outside Belfast  
Wed – Dec 14 - Familiarize with Area of Observation  
Thu - Dec 15 - Election Day  
Fri - Dec 16 - Observe Count and if count is finished, return to Belfast;  
If count is not finished, return to counting centre on Saturday to continue observation  
Sat - Dec 17 - Return to Belfast, debrief early-late afternoon, team dinner  
Sun - Dec 18 - Return home, or proceed with private plans

This is a completely self-funded mission.

The participation fee (in Pounds Sterling), subject to change, is as follows:

£ 984 Shared room, 6 nights, breakfasts included  
£1299 Single room, 6 nights, breakfasts included  
£ 725 Provide your own accommodation

The participation fee includes accommodations (breakfast included), mission fees, and in-country transportation. It does NOT include transportation to or from Northern Ireland, personal incidentals or meals. Drivers will be provided during the actual observation period.

On a case by case basis, we will support visa applications upon payment of a non-refundable deposit of £250.
